

Test all pages, not just product, checkout and shop pages.

Tips

- Move what you can to the Edge
- Let the server handle your cron
- Add index to metavalue db column

e Edge r cron db column

More tips

- Use Redis when it makes sense
- Use Object Cache Pro because it makes sense
- Use responsive images

Even more tips

- Offload search
- Host fonts locally
- Don't use large plugins for small tasks

That means automated testing.


Final Steps You have to put in effort to keep your WooCommerce site fast.
